Olympian Suresh Babu Memorial 9th Kerala State Youth Athletics Championship was held at Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram on 31st January and 1st February 2019. 303 athletes including 122 girls have participated in the meet. The championship was inaugurated **Sri. V Sunil Kumar, President, Kerala Olympic Association** in a meeting presided over by Sri. **M VelayudhanKutty, Former Secretary of KSAA** and Executive Committee member of AFI in the presence of **Prof. S P Pillai**, Chairman, Technical Committee, Athletics Federation of India , **Smt. Competitions were held for Boys and Girls Under 14 yrs, Boys and Girls Under 16 yrs, Youth Boys and Youth Girls Under 18 yrs, Junior Men and Junior Women Under 20yrs. The Kerala State team which is to participate in the 31st South Zone Junior Athletics Championship to be held at Udupi, Karnataka on 14th& 15th September 2019 and the 17th Federation Cup National Junior Athletics Championship to be held at Thiruvannamalai, Tamil Nadu from 24th to 26th September 2019 were selected mainly based on the performance of this meet. 1065 athletes including 506 female athletes representing 111 clubs/Institutions from all the 14 districts have participated in this meet.

On the first day of the competition an untoward incident happened while conducting the Hammer throw event for Youth Girls under 18, the thrown Hammer hit one of the Volunteers of the meet viz. Apheel Johnson and sustained serious head injury. The boy was immediately rushed to the nearby hospital from where he was referred to Kottayam Medical College. The first day events completed as per schedule. In the evening, after contacting the available members of the Executive Committee and Observer from KSSC it was decided to postpone the 2nd and 3rd days events of the championship to a further date. Here Association deeply regretted to record the sad demise of Apheel Johnson, the injured volunteer, on 22nd October at Medical College Hospital, Kottayam.

The balance events of the 63rd Kerala State Junior Athletics Championship was held at C H Mohammed Koya Stadium, University of Calicut, Thenhipalam, Malappuram District on 7th, 8th & 9th February 2020. The competitions conducted here were the continuation of the State Junior Athletics Championship conducted at Pala on 4th October 2019.

The events started at 2.30pm on 7th February and came to a close at 2.45pm on 9th February 2020.
